Dear Colleague,

CGS, Patna, was established in 2008 and has, subsequently, registered itself under the Society Registration Act 21, 1860 (Registration No. 2209/08-09). The Centre, since 2010, has held five National and two International Conferences, and each has been followed by the publication of the *Proceedings* of reach of the Conferences. The CGS, Patna not only holds Annual Conferences, but on a regular basis issues a journal entitled *Itihaas ki Khoj Mein*, since the foundation of the Centre. Along with this the Centre holds other social and academic activities from time to time.

I earnestly hope that you and colleagues, enrolling to the Centre for Gender Studies will attend the session and contribute to its success. It appears fairly commonsensical to us that boys, girls and other genders ought to be distinguished not only through physical markers like clothing, mode of amusements, sports activities, etc., but also through their respective cultural and behavioral patterns. The most common explanation for this prevailing attitude in society lays emphasis on the fact that God or Nature has created such differentiation. While the facts of our sex- the presence of distinctive male and female genitalia and reproductive organs- are incontrovertible, most of us perceptively feel that the categorising of the world as well as human behaviour into masculine and feminine is unwarranted. Women often question this enveloping perception of the society for not being viewed as 'autonomous being.'

Likewise, men after finding themselves in deeply discriminating position compared to women in terms of the evolution of emotional happiness and pleasure question the invasive sensitivity of the society which believe that they cannot be loving, nurturing and self-sacrificing as women. At various levels we more than often actively question the routine practices of gender. But unfortunately, we hardly question the fundamental premises on which these gender practices are based. We always shy away from the basic question of 'equality of sexes.'


We do not ponder about any possibility of change or transformation of the masculine and feminine attributes and roles. Similarly we hesitate to think whether men and women are coeval with each other. However, there has been a paradigm shift in last few decades which has witnessed the beginning of a radical departure in thinking and activism, leading to the rise of anti-systemic movements. There has emerged a questioning and critical scrutiny of the epistemological basis of social sciences prevailing since Enlightenment. As a result, issues of race, gender, sexuality, etc., began to draw academic attention. Thus there emerged a new kind of academics, new subjects of knowledge and new perspectives on knowledge, society and culture. It is in this brainstorming background that gender studies came to occupy the prime place in academic discourses. In order to sensitize society on the fundamental issues related to gender equality and to probe all critical questions, the Centre from its very inception has strenuously posed questions like; 'Why are people expected to be exclusively masculine or feminine?,' 'In which ways and by what means women have been rendered subordinate to men?,' 'How has patriarchy been formulated, cemented and carried forward till today?,' 'What are the means to convince the society that gender equality is must for humanity?,' etc., before the academic world in particular and society in general. Due to its all encompassing sphere, scholars from different disciplines and fields have participated and expressed their views in seminars, lectures, workshops, etc., organised by the Centre from time to time. We are proud to underline that people have responded very positively in our endeavour to bring gender issues in the mainstream of academic discussions. We hope that people will respond with same vigour and commitment and stoutly help in making the workshop a great success.

Hence, it is important for educational/professional academicians to be acquainted with the process of research i.e. research methodology. It is worth mentioning that research is a systematic process and the knowledge of research methodology helps to understand what to do in specific situation. Therefore, it is very important for a researcher to know all the aspects and steps of the research process in order to make it systematic to a greater degree and hence, to authenticate the reliability and validity of his/her work. This Training Course on Research Methodology shall make the young researcher familiar with the various aspects, tools and steps of conducting social science & Humanities research. The participants will be introduced to various methods of doing research i.e, quantitative, qualitative as well as mixed method approach. Special emphasis will be given to qualitative approaches like phenomenology, ethnography, ethno-methodology etc.

Research Methodology is a way to systematically solve the research problem. A researcher must know the rationale for using specific methods or techniques and establish their relevance. Methodology may be understood as a science of studying how research is done scientifically. Each discipline within the social sciences is informed by its research paradigms and each paradigm is associated with attendant methodologies. Social Science research assumes significance from the nature of problem being identified and the possible solutions, since it has a larger impact on the day to day activities of the common man. Over the years, it has been found that the quality of research output has been far from the much needed standards. A research work must act as a catalyst for further research to be undertaken in the said field. In the recent past, many new dimensions of research have emerged catering to the vast changes taking place in the present day social situation. The quality of research depends on the understanding of the research problem, the attendant research methodology and the appropriate tools used for the analysis

Recognizing the need for training in research and development of research competencies, Centre for Gender Studies, Patna is organizing a two day National Workshop on Research Methods. The focus of the workshop is on exposing participants to research methods which are employed in both qualitative and quantitative data. The following topics shall be covered:

4. Types of Research Design: Exploratory, Diagnostic, Descriptive: Experimental; Control Group & Experimental Group; Ex-Post Facto to Research Design
5. Concepts in Quantitative Research: Variables, Attributes
6. Hypotheses: Concept & Types of Hypotheses, Formulation of Hypothesis, Testing of Hypothesis
7. Nature & Types of Sampling: Probability Sampling: Simple Random Sampling, Proportionate and Disproportionate Stratified Random Sampling, Cluster Sampling- Non-Probability Sampling: Accidental Sampling, Quota Sampling, Purposive Sampling, Snowball Sampling
8. Tools of Data Collection: Primary & Secondary Questionnaire, Types and Formats; Schedule, Interview- Observation-Case Study Method-Content analysis-Rating Scales: Osgood, Bogardus Thurston; Likert; Guttman
- 9.. Interdisciplinary Research Methodology in Social Science
10. Interdisciplinary Research Methodology in Gender Issues
11. New Paradigms in Teaching, Learning and Evaluation
12. Innovative Strategies to Enhance Teaching Learning Process
13. Any other related topic.

The course delivery will be a mix of theory (why) and application (what) to inculcate the ability in participants to understand and assimilate the underlying assumptions, logic and theory behind these methods. The pedagogy of the workshop will have a composite blend of interactive lectures and hands-on training in the research methods. Emphasis will be on building concepts with the requisite rigour and analysis of research data. Participants will be provided with the relevant data sets for the purpose of analysis in order to facilitate experiential learning. It needs to be emphasized that the workshop will meet an important end of discussing quantitative tools for analysing qualitative data


Objectives of the Workshop

The workshop has been organized keeping in mind the emerging needs of the community of academics and researchers. As such, the objectives of the workshop are:

- To provide a stimulus to the keen learners comprising of research scholars, academicians and professionals
- To acquaint participants with the basic principles, concepts and problems of the listed research methods
- To provide an application-oriented experience of the techniques and models used in research
- To hone the analytical skills of participants in conceptualizing and understanding the research outputs.

Specifically, the objectives will be:

1. Preparation of research proposal – imparting basic training on how to conceive a sound research proposal
2. Enhancing skills to prepare an appropriate research design, including conducting an overview of literature, formulating research questions and hypotheses, collection of information and analysis,
3. Data Processing and analysis – techniques – how to read the data interpret the data, etc.
4. Enhance capacity for writing a research paper for publication
5. Field work training
6. Preparation of the report – how to write the final research report, etc.




