



Dear Colleague,

This Centre got its inception in the year 2008-09 and in due course registered itself under Society Registration Act 21, 1860 (Registration No. 2209/08). The Centre has till today held five National and one International Conferences since 2010 and each has been followed by publication of the Proceedings of respective Conferences. The Centre for Gender Studies, Patna not only holds Annual Conference but on regular basis issues Journal under its aegis entitled *Itihaas ki Khoj Mein*, since the foundation of the Centre. Along with this the Centre holds other social and academic activities from time to time.

I earnestly hope that all your colleagues, yourself included who are becoming members of the Centre for Gender Studies attend the session and contribute to its success in Gender studies which is attracting academic attention globally. It appears fairly commonsensical to us that boys, girls and the third sex ought to be distinguished not only through physical marker dress-pattern, diet mode of amusements, sports activities, etc., but also through their respective cultural and behavior pattern. Any infringements of these conventional parameters lead one to admonish girls for behaving 'like boys' and to condemn boys for being timorous 'like girls.' The most common explanation for this prevailing attitude in the society emphasizes on the fact that God or Nature has created such differentiation. While the facts of our sex- the presence of distinct male and female genitalia and reproductive organs- are incontrovertible, most of us perceptively feel that the categorising world as well as human behaviour into masculine and feminine is unwarranted. Women often question the enveloping perception of the society for not being viewed as 'autonomous being.' Likewise, men after finding themselves in deeply discriminated position compared to women in terms of the evolution of emotional happiness and pleasure question the invasive sensitivity of the society which believe that they cannot be loving, nurturing and self-sacrificing as women can be. The emanating fact at various levels we more than often actively question the routine practices of gender. But unfortunately, we hardly question the fundamental premises on which these gender practices are based. We always shy away from the basic question of 'equating sexes.'

We do not ponder about any possibility of change or transformation of the masculine and feminine attributes and Similarly we hesitate to think whether men and women can coexist with each other. However, there has been a paradigm shift in the last few decades which has witnessed the beginning of a radical departure in thinking and activism, leading to the rise of systematic movements. There emerged a questioning and critical scrutiny of the epistemological basis of social sciences prevailing since Enlightenment. As a result, issues of race, gender, sexuality, etc., began to draw academic attention. In this emerging new kind of academics, new subject of knowledge and new perspectives on knowledge, society and culture is in this brainstorming background gender studies came to occupy the prime place in academic discourses. In order to sensitize the society on the fundamental issues related to gender equality and to probe all critical questions the Centre from its very inception has strenuously put the questions like; 'Why are people expected to be exclusively masculine or feminine? which ways and by what means women have been rendered subordinate to men?', 'How the patriarchy has been formed, cemented and carried forward till today?', 'What are the means to convince the society that gender equality is a reality for all humanity?', etc., before the academic world in particular and the society in general. Due to its all encompassing nature, scholars from different disciplines and fields have participated and expressed their views in the seminars, lectures, workshops, etc., organised by the Centre from time to time. Brief Sketch of the Centre for Gender Studies, Patna : Gender is everywhere. Any infringement of these conventional parameters lead one to admonish girls for behaving 'like boys' and likewise condemn boys for being 'smoochy like girls'. The most common explanation for this prevailing attitude in the society gives emphasis on the fact that God or Nature has created such differentiation. While the facts of our sex- the presence of distinctive male and female genitalia and reproductive organs- are incontrovertible, most of us perceptively feel that the categorising of the world as well as human behaviour as masculine and feminine is unwarranted. Women often question the enveloping perception of the society for not being viewed as 'autonomous beings.' Likewise, men, after finding themselves in deeply discriminated position compared to women, in terms of the evolution of emotional happiness and pleasure, question the invasive sensitivity of the society which believe that they cannot be loving, nurturing and self-sacrificing as women can be. The emanating fact is that at various levels we more than often actively question the routine practices of gender. But unfortunately, we hardly raise a query about the fundamental premises- which these gender practices are based. We always shy away from the basic question of 'equality of sexes'. We do not ponder about any possibility of change or transformation of the masculine and feminine attributes and roles. Similarly we hesitate to think whether men and women can be coeval with each other. However, there has been a paradigm shift in the last few decades

'Today's women are looking for more liberal horizon'

PATNA: What do the hit songs like *Murri badnam hai darling tere liye...* and *Sheela ki jawani...* reflect in context of the present-day society pleading for equal status to women?

The answer is simple. Its post-modernism wave of feminist movement that has changed the scenario in the 21st century when women are searching a broader and more liberal horizon for them, said Patna University (PU) vice-chancellor, Dr Sudipta Adhikari on Monday.

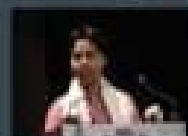

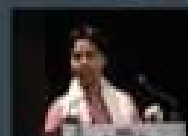

(डॉ) इंद्रजीत प्रसाद रॉय, प्रधानाचार्य कॉलेज ऑफ कॉमर्स आर्ट्स एंड साइंस, मुख्य वक्ता प्रो. श्यामल किशोर, एसोसिएट प्रोफेसर, टी पी एस कॉलेज, स्वागत भाषण, प्रोफेसर संजय स्वर्णकार, इतिहास विभाग, गवर्नमेंट के० आर० जी० पी०

पर चर्चा करते हुए कहा कि समावेशी विकास में तकनीकी भूमिका महत्वपूर्ण है, परन्तु इसके भी गुण - दोष हैं। उन्होंने आर्थिक विकास में नैतिक मूल्य के साथ साथ लिंग विषमता का मुख्य पहलू माना है। तथा आज का मुख्य मुद्दा भी यही है। वहीं प्रो.(डॉ) इंद्रजीत प्रसाद रॉय ने सतत विकास में महिलाओं की भागीदारी पर चर्चा करते हुए कहा कि वर्तमान समय में लिंग विषमता स्वीकार नहीं है।
